Secretary Textiles has appealed for submitting the proposal under the REF as the deadlines are very close and help in the process of national building by boosting the Apparel and Garment units in the North-Eastern States.

BACKGROUND:

1. The scheme for Apparel and Garment making centres in each of the 8 North Eastern States has been launched to provide a fillip to the organized textiles industry in the North Eastern Region.
2. Each Apparel and Garment making centres consisting of 3 units of 100 machines and the facilities will be made available to entrepreneurs' for skilling of local youth in Apparel and Garment making and also for production.
